Conditional Capital Outlay includes vehicles and equipment that are necessary and warranted, but are not within the scope of the City's projected resource availability for the upcoming budgeted fiscal year. Each fiscal year after the City completes the financial audits, the Office of the City Manager, in conjunction with the Finance Director, Fleet Services Manager and impacted department directors, will re-evaluate these items for purchase based on a revised projection of available resources. If these items are approved for purchase, or if items scheduled for FY2027 are moved up to FY2026, budget adjustments will be requested at Mid-Biennium.
