


Hello, my name is Carty. Welcome to my grocery store! Why don't we take a tour and see just how many items can be recycled!

Grab your shopping cart and let's begin!




2. While at the grocery store, you will find lots of different kinds of canned vegetables. Write the name of your favorite vegetables on each can.

Now, we are in the soup aisle. Look at all of the choices you have to make a delicious and healthy hot bowl of soup!




4. Let's write the names of your favorite soft drinks and juices on the cans below!
