Welcome to the Parks and Recreation 2025 Events Calendar! My name is Alison Hall and having spent many wonderful years with Auburn Parks and Recreation, I am overjoyed to return as your director and contribute to the vibrant community we all cherish.

As you browse this year's calendar, I hope you discover events, programs, and activities that excite and inspire you. Whether it's trying a new activity, joining a league, or simply enjoying our beautiful parks, there is something for everyone in 2025.

And on Saturday, April 26 we will celebrate a much-loved event in our community – Auburn CityFest – held at our beautiful 124-acre Kiesel Park. We hope you will mark your calendars and plan to spend the day with us and enjoy live music, food, arts & crafts and fine art vendors, children's activities, and so much more.

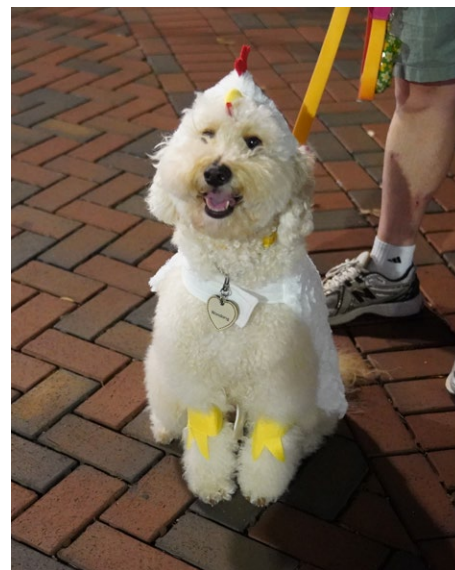
