



Greetings:

Welcome to our Parks and Recreation calendar for 2023.

In 2018 a list of priorities for Parks and Recreation projects was undertaken to address the needs of the community for sports, programs, the arts and facilities and parks. In 2021/22 several of the projects were completed with a wonderful response from our citizens. These included the Town Creek Inclusive Playground, Dinius Park, and the Sam Harris Greenway. Three different areas of our city with projects meant to improve our service to the community.

In the next two years several projects will be contracted out or are already under construction. Those under construction include the Auburn Soccer Complex addition with a building and three turf fields, the renovations and addition to the Jan Dempsey Community Arts Center, the Lake Wilmore Community Center and four addition multipurpose fields at Lake Wilmore, additional pickleball courts, renovations to the Margie Piper Bailey Fields and the Saugahatchee Greenway. The Boykin area development with a splash pad and eventually another community center will be done at the end of this phase. Both centers will have space for programs of all ages.

The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board is continuing to evaluate needs and make recommendations to the City Council. Some other projects include a greenway from Moores Mill Road to Janet Drive and baseball and softball fields as well as disc golf. Other projects are also being considered. 
