Alabama Department of Archives and History Tour - January 5th, 9:30 AM - 3:30 PM

This is a great opportunity to tour the Alabama Department of Archives. Founded in 1901, the Archives was the first state-funded archival and historical agency in the country. Although it had been a state for more than eighty years and boasted a rich, centuries-old history, Alabama previously had no formal system in place for the collection and preservation of its records. Consequently, those materials were scattered throughout the state. Early Alabama historians by necessity traversed the old towns and former capitals of the state, seeking out its recorded history. The desire to correct this deficiency, combined with interest in improving public education and professionalizing the field of history, was the impetus needed to create the agency.
