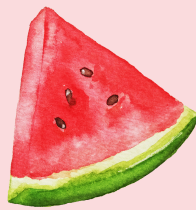

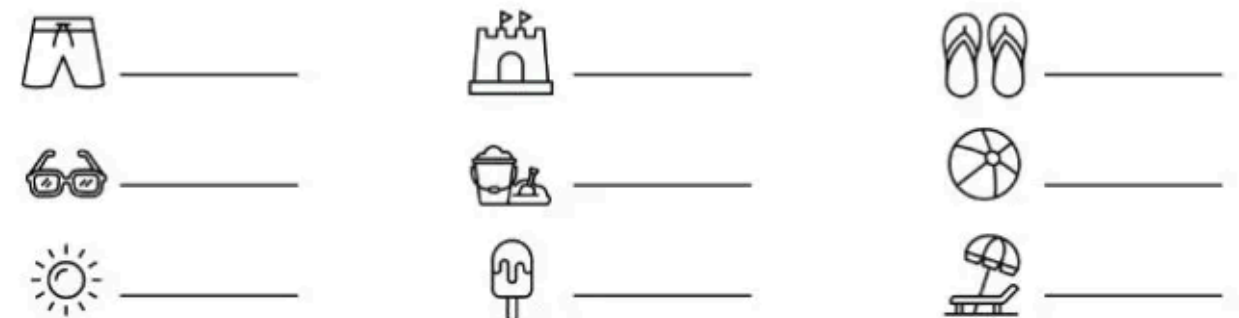
Young's Plant Farm
