Join us as we travel to Atlanta, GA to experience Atlanta's most popular food hall! **\$100 per person, please bring extra money for dinner!**

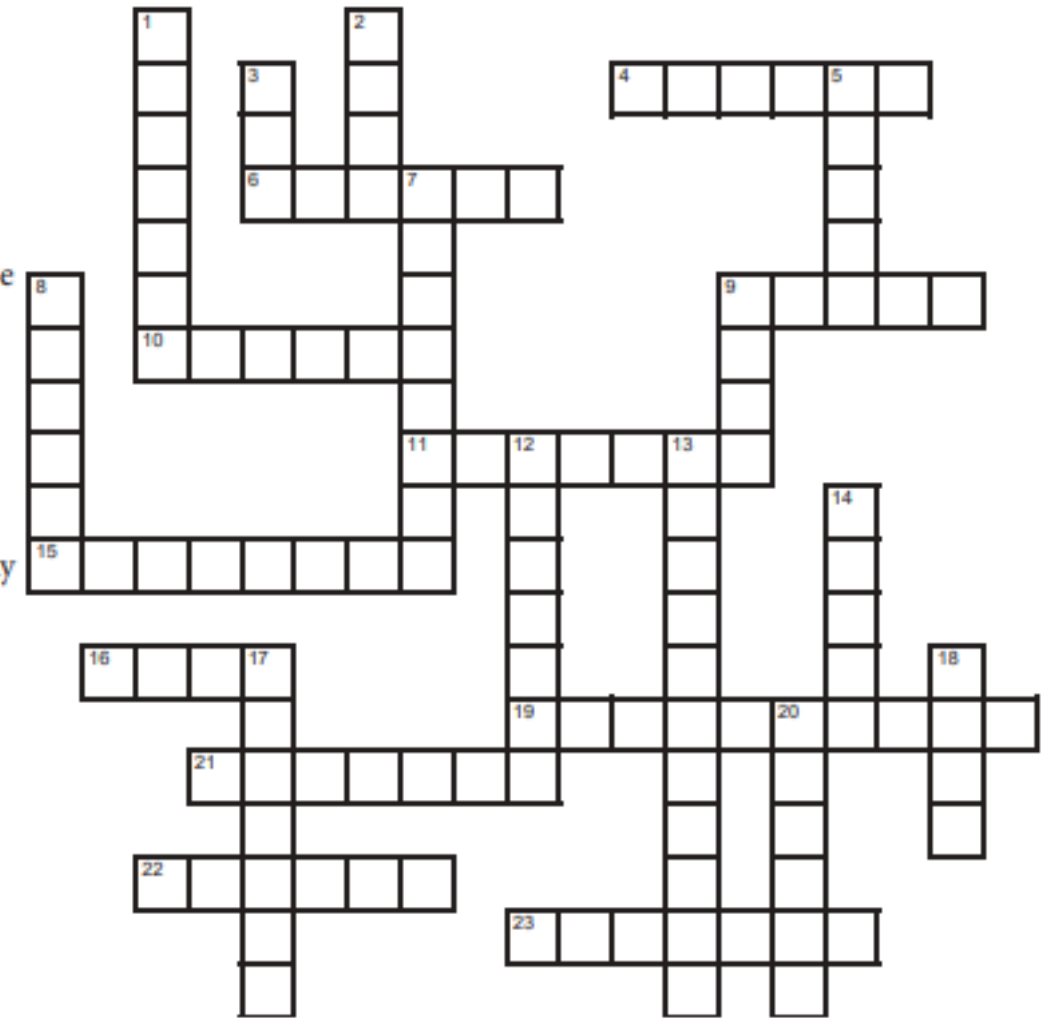
