The Legacy of Our Founding Documents, offered by Auburn University's Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI), explores how the Declaration of Independence, Constitution, and Bill of Rights have shaped American identity, law, religious freedom, and the struggle for African American citizenship. Coordinated by Professor Emeritus Larry Gerber, the course features presentations by distinguished humanities scholars, with the final session highlighting guest experts Sidonia Serafini and Barbara McCaskill discussing African American Studies and related historical perspectives. The course will be held every Thursday beginning September 17, 2026, from 11:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. at the Harris Center. Attendance is FREE, but registration is required.

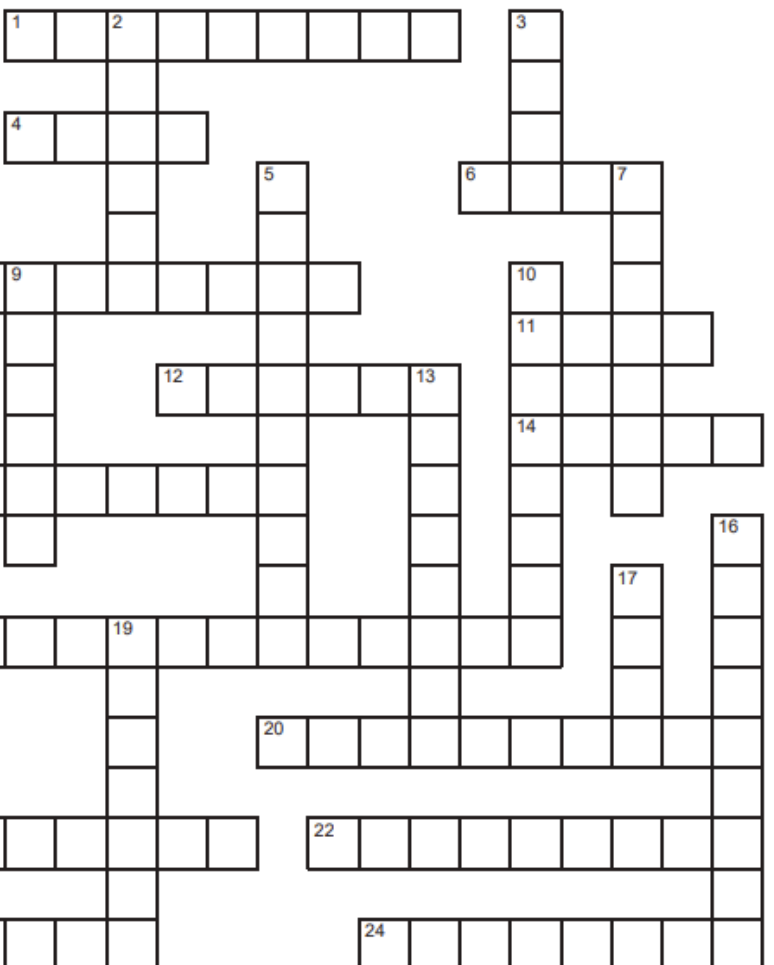
