



# MOTORCYCLE CROWD CONTROL AND ESCORT COURSE

This course will prepare officers to conduct hands on crowd control & escort maneuvers alongside veteran Auburn and IPTM certified police motorcycle instructors during Auburn University gameday escorts.

## What to Bring - Required

- Your department-issued motorcycle, currently assigned to you or a similar motorcycle approved for street riding exercises. The bike should be in good condition and have a pre-course maintenance check.
- Complete on-duty belt
- Uniform

This training is physically demanding and involves long hours. Any simulated training environment cannot rival the experience gained in this real-life training event.



## Other Requirements

- **You must have a motorcycle driver's license endorsement, if required by resident state**
- **You must sign a waiver of responsibility**
- **Restricted to active law enforcement personnel**

There are **no fees** associated with this training; however, officers will be responsible for their own lodging, meals, and other expenses.
