City of Auburn



City of Auburn offers Intro to tennis and recreational tennis instruction. The City Classes are a structured and cost effective setting to get introduced to tennis. The City Classes are co-ed and are divided into Age Groups: 4-5, 6-8, 9-11, 12-17. Students learn basic techniques, scoring and tennis etiquets. Players can graduate to intermediate levels if they demonstrate sound basic skills, self control, sustain a 10 ball rally, serve and know how to keep score. Players going through the recreational junior program should be able to play tennis matches as adults and enjoy the sport for a lifetime.

Intermediate Junior Tennis

Progression into Intermediate tennis indicates that students are now ready or getting ready to play organized competitive tennis matches. Organized competitive tennis matches either fall under USTA 10-Under NetGeneration or USTA 11-18 Junior Tennis. There are a variety of options and approaches for intermediate youth tennis at Yarbrough Tennis Centre. You can choose from Private Instruction to Private Group Instruction, JTT, Junior Play Days, Junior Team Challenges or USTA Junior Level 6 and 7 tournaments.

Advance Junior Tennis

Players that falls into this level of play have demonstrated through competitive play that they are reaching playing levels defined by a rating system. The 2 accepted rating systems to determine your playing level are:



Auburn Highschool Varsity Boys Average: 5UTR / Auburn Highschool Varsity Girls Average: 4UTR

High Performance Junior Tennis (Travel Tennis)

High performance refers to junior tennis players that are actively chasing USTA Junior Ranking Points, WTN numbers and UTR numbers with the goal of playing Collegiate Tennis or even Professional Tennis. High Performance Junior players regularly travel in and out of state to play in USTA, UTR and WTN tournaments.
