

Introductory Computer Numeric Control (CNC) Operator Training



The Introductory Computer Numeric Control (CNC) Operator Course prepares students for employment as an entry level machine operator in the manufacturing industry. The program provides applied skills in the operation of Computer Numeric Control machines for current and future needs of the manufacturing industry.

The Introductory CNC Operator course is a 60-contact hour non-credit course that focuses on the basics of machine operation including understanding machine safety, manufacturing floor safety, converting fractions to decimals, adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing with whole numbers, fractions and decimals, converting standard units to metric, basic print reading, reading precision measurement equipment and understanding the basics of running a CNC program.

Classes will meet in person on the Opelika Campus of Southern Union in the Center for Integrated Manufacturing
